#### MAIN SEWER LINE JETTING IS SCHEDULED FOR THE LAST WEEK IN AUGUST

You may notice a slight sewer odour inside your home during this procedure. If there is a smell we recommend opening a window for a few minutes, and pouring water down sinks and floor drains to help clear it.

Sewer main cleaning helps prevent blockages and backups by removing buildup in the mains, including tree roots, grease, grit and sand. This important maintenance work keeps our sewer mains flowing, reduces the potential for nuisance odours, and helps protect our infrastructure.

#### SaskWater Helpful tips to save water and money!

This summer, save a drop. Save a lot. With these simple water conservation tips:

- Watering your lawn for one hour or less, twice a week is sufficient
- © For best results, avoid watering during the hottest time of the day or when it's raining or windy.
- Use sprinklers that throw big drops of water close to the ground. Smaller drops of water and mist often evaporate before reaching your lawn.
- Aerate, compost and weed your lawn to increase moisture retention.
- When mowing, cut the top 1/3 of the grass and leave clippings behind. They are a natural fertilizer and help the soil retain moisture.
- © Collect water in a rain barrel and use it to water outdoor plants.
- Instead of washing your car with a running hose, use a bucket and sponge, then rinse using a trigger nozzle on your hose.
- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean your driveway or sidewalk
