A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STAR CITY TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE TOWN, PURSUANT TO SECTION 137 OF THE URBAN MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1984, AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO.

The Council of the Town of Star City in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw, the expression:

> "gun", "firearm", "device that discharge a projectile" shall have the same meaning as given them in "The Criminal Code".

- 2. Subject to Section 3, no person shall discharge or allow anyone to discharge any gun, firearm, or other device that is designed for or cabable of discharging a projectile or projectiles of any type within the corporate limits of the Town of Star City.
 - The provisions of Section 2 do not apply to a person
 - (a) a police officer;

- a registered member of a gun club or similar organization while engaged in target practice at a recognized range; or
- (c) taking part in an event approved by the majority of council.
- A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$25. nor more than \$100.
 - This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of passing thereof.
