

A BYLAW RESPECTING ANIMAL CONTROL.

The Council of the Town of Star City in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

No person shall keep any cattle, horses, swine, sheep, goats or poultry, nor shall any cattle, horses, swine, sheep, goats or poultry be permitted to be kept at any time within the limits of the town lying south of Railway Avenue.

No person shall graze any cattle, horses, sheep or goats, nor shall any cattle, horses, sheep or goats be permitted to graze at any time within the limits of the town lying south of Railway Avenue.

No person shall permit to run at large any cattle, horses, swine, sheep, goats or poultry within the limits of the town.

No person shall keep any cattle, horses, swine, sheep, goats or poultry, at any time beyond the area designated in Section 1 hereof except within a barn, shed or pen especially elected for such its purpose and approved by the town council.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval of the Minister of Health.

Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provisions of this bylaw shall be liable upon summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor exceeding \$100.00 and costs.
