#### Winter Reminders

- $\sim$  Park vehicles in driveways and  $\underline{NOT}$  on the streets during winter months to ensure the grader can get through for snow removal. If you need to park on the streets, please have your vehicle moved after a big snow fall so it does not get blocked in by the snow plow.
- $\sim$  Remember to bring in your garabage/recycle bins off the streets once they have been emptied to allow for the proper snow removal
- ~ When removing snow from your property, please be considerate of your neighbors and do not blow into their yards. Also do not push snow onto the streets from your driveways/walkways.
- ~ The driveway wing, when lowered should reduce the amount of snow left on driveway approaches but it will not eliminate a snow ridge. Unless this ridge is quite significant (more than 12 inches) staff will not return to remove it this also applies to the ridges left in the back alley. Anything less than 12 inches is to be removed by the homeowner.


