#### **BYLAW 498-2016**

# A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN BOUNDARIES

The Council of the Town of Star City in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Under Section 9 of the <u>All-Terrain Vehicles Act</u>, All Terrain vehicles shall be permitted to operate on the travelled portion of the whole or any part of a roadway within the Town of Star City subject to the following conditions:
- a) The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of origin or destination within the Town of Star City corporate limits.
- b) The operator meets all applicable requirements of the <u>All-Terrain Vehicles Act</u> and the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u> and any bylaw of the Town of Star City regulating the operation of vehicles.
- 2. An operator who does not comply with the conditions set forth in Section 1 shall be guilty of an offence and subject to the penalties set forth in the <u>All-Terrain Vehicles Act</u> and the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u> or any bylaw of the Town of Star City regulating the operation of vehicles.
- 3. No person shall operate an All-Terrain Vehicle between the hours of  $11:00\ pm$  to  $7:00\ am.$
- 4. This bylaw will not pertain to the Town of Star City when employees are using an All-Terrain Vehicle in the course of their daily duties.
