Compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. Please keep them at a manageable weight and remember no rocks or garbage!

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

Please be mindful when having a backyard fire and watch the weather carefully i.e windy, dry conditions, etc.) Be considerate of your neighbors i.e smoke from campfires can sometimes be a nuisance to others. Please keep watch of your fire at all times and have a way to put out the fire close to your fire pit (watering hose or bucket of water). Have fun & Stay safe.

Just a reminder to residents to please ensure your moving your vehicles at least every 48 hours so we can maintain the streets. Thank you.




# STAR CITY GRADUATING CLASS OF 2020 HAS BEEN POSTPONED!
