Compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. Please keep them at a manageable weight and remember no rocks or garbage!

Compost is scheduled to be picked up Monday & Wednesdays (if time & weather permits)

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier

BYLAW 520-2020 - A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN BOUNDRIES

 a) The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of origin within the Town of Star City corporate limits to a point outside the Town of Star City corporate limits (direct in direct out). All-Terrain Vehicles are not to be used as a mode of transportation within the Town of Star City.
