ATTENTION DOG OWNERS!!

Please be advised that your animal must be kept on your own property. Please keep your pet(s) on a leash while out walking.

If you are walking your animal and they defecate, you are expected to pick it up and dispose of it in a sanitary manner. If your animal excretes on your neighbor's property, you can be held responsible for removing it. Thank you for being a responsible pet owner.

The Bylaw Officer/Commissionaire will be randomly checking for pet licences & driving around doing yard inspections during the monthly visits.

Please make sure your pet's tags are up to date & you are keeping your properties neat & tidy. Thank you.

Compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office.

Please keep them at a manageable weight and remember no rocks, dog waste or garbage! Compost is scheduled to be picked up Monday & Wednesdays (if time & weather permits)

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.
