Dust Control was applied on May 11th

Street Sweeping was done on June 2nd.

The Commissionaires were here at the end of May. During a tour around town it was noted there were quite a few nuisance properties. Most of the properties noted, have untidy yards with piles of materials stored improperly. Storage of miscellaneous property needs to be off the ground and stacked neatly because rats, mice and skunks make their homes in these types of areas. Lots of yards have "junked" vehicles; all vehicles, boats, trailers, etc. need to be licensed properly, or covered with a tarp. Temporary sheds, have taken a beating this year with the winds being so strong. Ripped and torn coverings need to be replaced or removed.

The Commissionaires will be back at the end of June and will be reviewing the town. Please do your part and keep our town looking neat & tidy. Thank you.

Compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. Please keep them at a manageable weight and remember no rocks or garbage! Compost is scheduled to be picked up Monday & Wednesdays (if time & weather permits)

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

BYLAW 520-2020 - A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN BOUNDRIES

 a) The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of origin within the Town of Star City corporate limits to a point outside the Town of Star City corporate limits (direct in direct out). All-Terrain Vehicles are not to be used as a mode of transportation within the Town of Star City.


STAR CITY LIBRARY NEWS:
