Compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. **Please keep them at a manageable weight** and remember no rocks, dog waste or garbage! Compost is scheduled to be picked up Monday & Wednesdays (if time & weather permits)

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

- Sign up patrol for library card if they do not already have one
- Ensure patrol understands the borrowing guidelines
- A Provincial Regional Park Guide will be available with each pass
- You may borrow the pass for 1 week at a time
- No pre-booking
- First come first serve
