Please keep watch of your fire at all times and have a way to put out the fire close to your fire pit (watering hose or bucket of water). Have fun & Stay safe.

Compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. Please keep them at a manageable weight and remember no rocks or garbage!

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

BYLAW 520-2020 - A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN BOUNDRIES

1. a) The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of orgin within the Town of Star City corporate limits to a point outside the Town of Star City corporate limits (direct in direct out). All-Terrain Vehicles

are not to be used as a mode of transportation within the Town of Star City.


