## ASSESSMENT ROLL NOTICE TOWN OF STAR CITY

Notice is hereby given that the assessment roll for the Town of Star City for the year 2022 has been prepared and is open to inspection in the office of the assessor from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm and from 12:30 pm to 4:30 pm Monday to Friday from April 25, 2022 to May 30, 2022.

A bylaw pursuant to Section 214 of *The Municipalities Act* has been passed and the assessment notices has been sent as required.

The Appeal Fee of \$50.00 per property must accompany the appeal and is to be payable to the Town of Star City, Box 250, Star City, Sk. S0E 1P0 by 30th day of May, 2022.

Spring has sprung and the Town is once again picking up compost and tree branches in an effort to keep the Town looking neat & tidy. This service is provided free of charge however please note that our Public Works staff are busy during the summer months, so a limited amount of time is assigned for this task. Monday & Wednesday mornings (if time & weather permits) have been designated for compost & tree branch pick up. If you have an excess amount of trees and/or compost, please contact our office to make arrangements to have them removed. Additional charges may apply. Just a reminder NOT to put dog waste into the compost bags – it belongs in the garbage!

As a reminder compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. Remember to keep compost bags at a manageable weight and remember no rocks or garbage! Please put compost in clear bags and not in boxes!

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> – AUGUST 31<sup>ST</sup>**

The Bylaw Officer/Commissionaire will be randomly checking for pet licences & driving around doing yard inspections during the monthly visits.

Please make sure your pet's tags are up to date & you are keeping your properties neat & tidy.
