Spring has sprung and the Town is once again picking up compost and tree branches in an effort to keep the Town looking neat & tidy. This service is provided free of charge however please note that our Public Works staff are busy during the summer months, so a limited amount of time is assigned for this task. Monday & Wednesday mornings (if time & weather permits) have been designated for compost & tree branch pick up. If you have an excess amount of trees and/or compost, please contact our office to make arrangements to have them removed. Additional charges may apply. Just a reminder NOT to put dog waste into the compost bags - it belongs in the garbage!

As a reminder compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. Remember to keep compost bags at a manageable weight and remember no rocks or garbage! Bags the contain garbage WILL NOT BE PICKED UP! Please put compost in clear bags and not in boxes!

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10-foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF **ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN BOUNDARIES**

The Council of the Town of Star City in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Under Section 9 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act, All Terrain vehicles shall be permitted to operate on the travelled portion of the whole or any part of a roadway within the Town of Star City subject to the following conditions:
- a) The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of origin - within the Town of Star City corporate limits to a point outside the Town of Star City corporate limits (direct in direct out). All Terrain Vehicles are not to be used as a mode of transportation within the Town of Star City.
- b) The operator meets all applicable requirements of the All <u>Terrain Vehicles Act</u> and the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u> and any bylaw of the Town of Star City regulating the operation of vehicles.
- 3 No person shall operate an All Terrain Vehicle between the hours of 10:00 pm to 7:00 am.
- 4. This bylaw will not pertain to the Town of Star City when employees are using an All Terrain Vehicle in the course of their daily duties.


