Spring has sprung and the Town is once again picking up compost and tree branches in an effort to keep the Town looking neat & tidy. This service is provided free of charge however please note that our Public Works staff are busy during the summer months, so a limited amount of time is assigned for this task. Monday & Wednesday mornings (if time & weather permits) have been designated for compost & tree branch pick up. If you have an excess amount of trees and/or compost, please contact our office to make arrangements to have them removed. Additional charges may apply. Just a reminder NOT to put dog waste into the compost bags – it belongs in the garbage!

Please keep your pet(s) on your own property and on a leash when off your property. Please make sure to pick up after your pets and be a respectful pet owner.

Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

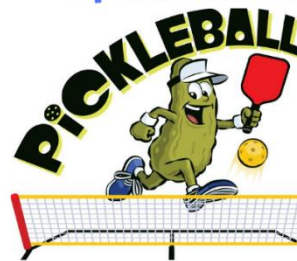
