**Water Bill Payments & Disconnection Notice**

**Utility Bylaw 488-2014**

15. Accounts shall be paid by the fifteenth day of the month, immediately following the month of service.

16. If the arrears on an account are not paid in full with seven (7) days of the billing in which they are identified as arrears and which contains a message about disconnection, the water service may be disconnected without further notice. In instances where the arrears relate to a rental property, a copy of the billing setting out the arrears shall be forwarded to the landlord – with a notation to this effect on the billing provided to the renter.

**Disconnection/Reconnection Charges – Policy 14-01**

2. If water is off for non-payment there is a \$50.00 reconnect fee in addition to arrears paid in full before water service will be restored.
