Spring has sprung and the Town is once again picking up compost and tree branches in an effort to keep the Town looking neat & tidy. This service is provided free of charge however please note that our Public Works staff are busy during the summer months, so a limited amount of time is assigned for this task. Monday & Wednesday mornings (if time & weather permits) has been designated for compost & tree branch pick up. If you have an excess amount of trees and/or compost, please contact our office to make arrangements to have them removed. Additional charges may apply.

As a reminder compost bags are available free of charge at the Town Office. Please keep them at a manageable weight and remember no rocks or garbage!

Branches should be stacked on the boulevard piled parallel to the road in no more than 8-10 foot lengths. The reason we like to have them alongside the boulevard is for easy access and removal. Removal with the skid steer can damage boulevards so keeping them on a harder surface makes it easier for everyone.

Public Works will be grading streets to prepare for the dust control application. Being that Monday's are Greenland garbage/recycle pick up days we will be aiming to do streets Tuesday's – Friday's – weather permitting. Please make sure to remove garbage/recycle bins from the street once they have been emptied.

- ★ Dust Control is booked for the week of May 16th 23rd.
- ★ Street Sweeping is booked for the end of May.

Please watch for updates on our Website and Facebook page to ensure your vehicles are removed from the streets.




