POLICY NO. 20-02 FALSE ALARM POLICY - Effective" January 1st, 2021

<u>1.PURPOSE</u>: To reduce the number of Fire Department responses to False Alarms by promoting the proper use and maintenance of alarm systems and assigning a set of procedures and associated rates.

<u>**4.FEES**</u> a) False Alarm fees may be charged to the property owner and are subject to Town of Star City payment terms, interest rates and collection polices. Fees will be charged as follows:

i) First False Alarm in the calendar year - no charge, a courtesy letter will be issued to the property owner with instructions to contact the alarm system provider to reduce the likelihood of further occurrences. Notification rated rates for further False Alarms will be included in the letter.

ii) Additional False Alarms - please refer to Schedule A Policy No. 20-03 Fire Department Policy (noted below).
