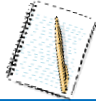

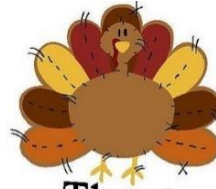

Star City Housing Authority is seeking a GROUNDS MAINTENANCE CONTRACTOR

This is a contract position responsible for the maintenance of the grounds of the Housing Authority units in Star City. Maintenance Contractor responsibilities include: Develop (with the Manger) and execute maintenance plans and schedules, ensure timely attention to maintenance issues and seasonal grounds requirements, act as a contact person for the Housing Authority when required, ensure assets are maintained in good repair and operated in an efficient, effective manner. The Maintenance Contractor receives general direction from the Manger and reports indirectly to the Board of Directors.

The successful candidate must be able to perform or sub-contract the following duties:

- Seasonal grounds maintenance (snow removal, grass cutting, watering, weed control, cleaning of eave troughs and extensions).

In addition, the Maintenance Contractor must be able to:

- Communicate effectively, verbal and written
- Maintain confidentiality
- Work collaboratively with the Manger
