2020 MUNICIPAL ELECTION!!

Do you have an interest in municipal politics?

Have you considered running for municipal council?

Anyone interested in running for council is encouraged to come to the town office and pick up a nomination paper starting **September 21st to October 7th until 4:00pm.**

Nomination Papers & Public Disclosure Statements will also be available to print from the Town's Website

*** Nomination Day is October 7th – Office Hours will be 8:00am – 4:30pm (The office will be open over lunch).**

Accepted Nomination Papers

No nomination is complete or shall be accepted unless the candidate's acceptance of nomination statement is

- Signed by the nominee
- Witnessed by two individuals
- Accompanied by the municipalities Public Disclosure Statement and
- Accompanied by a Criminal Record Check (Bylaw 499-2016)

Criminal Record Checks

Criminal record checks are to be completed at the Melfort RCMP detachment.

- Please visit Melfort City Hall to pay for your criminal record check
- Phone the Melfort RCMP detachment at 752-6420 to make an appointment.
- Bring your receipt from Melfort City Hall along with 2 pieces of ID
- Masks are required

If elected, the fee from your criminal record check will be refunded by the Town of Star City.

Election Candidate Eligibility

Persons eligible for nomination as a candidate in any Saskatchewan municipality must meet all the requirements listed for the municipality they wish to run in:

Urban (city, town or village)

- is at least 18 years old on the day of the election.
- is not disqualified pursuant to this or any other Act.
- is a Canadian citizen at the time that he/she submits the nomination paper.
- has lived in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months immediately preceding the date on which he/she submitted the nomination paper, AND:
- has lived in that municipality, or on land now in that municipality, for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the date on which he/she submitted the nomination paper.

Voter Eligibility

To vote in a city, town or village election in Saskatchewan, you must:

- be a Canadian citizen;
- be at least 18 years of age and one of the following;
- have lived in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months immediately before election day and:
 - a) lived in the municipality (or on land now in the municipality) for at least three consecutive months immediately before election day; or
 - b) be the owner of assessable land situated in the municipality (or land now situated in the municipality) for at least three consecutive months immediately before election day.
