MAIN SEWER LINE JETTING IS SCHEDULED FOR LATE
SEPTEMBER/EARLY OCTOBER.

You may notice a slight sewer odour inside your home during this procedure. If there is a smell we recommend opening a window for a few minutes, and pouring water down sinks and floor drains to help clear it.

Sewer main cleaning helps prevent blockages and backups by removing buildup in the mains, including tree roots, grease, grit and sand. This important maintenance work keeps our sewer mains flowing, reduces the potential for nuisance odours, and helps protect our infrastructure.

LARGE GARDEN COMPOST – things such as corn stalks, sunflower stalks, rhubarb leaves, etc. that are too bulky and big to put in the clear compost bags can be neatly piled by your regular compost bags and the public work employees will pick it up with the fork. Please ensure it is piled neatly for a clean removal.

BACK to SCHOOL



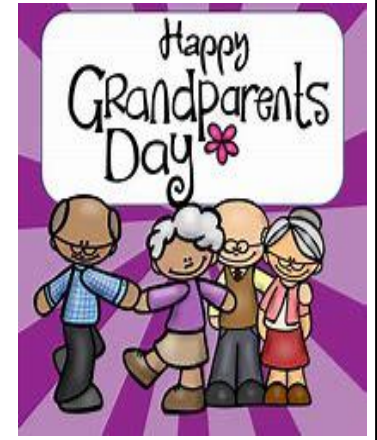
Star City School Grade 1 - 12 Start started back on Tuesday September 3rd and Kindergarten on Wednesday, September 4th

DOROTHY MAGNUS from Tisdale

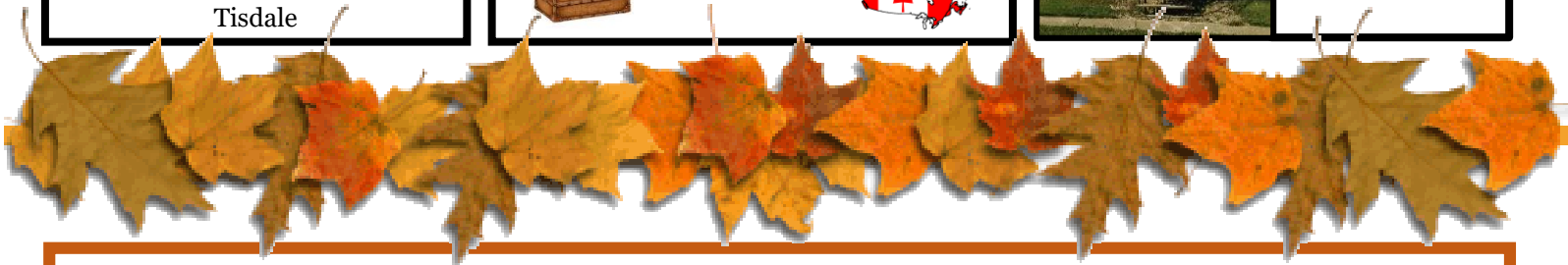
The Star City Library will have a Canada Day One exhibit on display for the months of August & September.
