METAL PICK UP CONTINUES ...

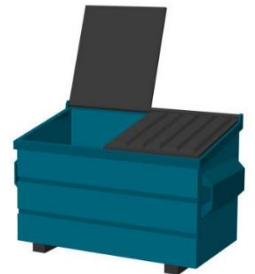
