Compost bags are available at the Town Office free of charge to residents for grass clippings, leaves, pinecones, garden scraps etc. Please leave them near the back alley for pick up.

TREE BRANCHES

Just a friendly reminder that when trimming trees in your yard, please stack them on the boulevard or near the alley, piled parallel to the road, no more than 8-10 ft. lengths

NOTE: IF BRANCHES ARE NOT NEATLY PILED OR ARE TOO BIG TO BE PICKED UP BY OUR PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEES, CHARGES MAY BE APPLIED.

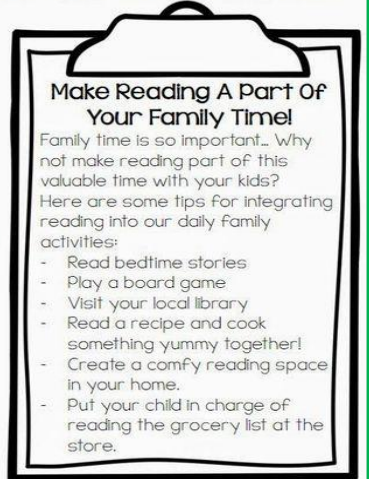
Reading At Home...

Choose Books That Are At An Appropriate Reading Level For Your Child

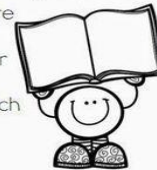

- Choose books that match your child's likes and interests.
